Kavarga	ক	খ	গ	ঘ	ঙ
	ka	kha	ga	gha	ng
chavarga	চ	ছ	জ	ঝ	ঞ
	cha	chha	ja	jha	na (yan)
tavarga	ত	ঠ	ঢ	ধ	ণ
	ta	tha	da	dha	na
tavarga	ত	ঘ	ঢ	ঝ	ণ
	ta	tha	da	dha	na
pavarga	প	ফ	ব	ভ	ম
	pa	pha	ba	bha	ma

Note: (i) Every consonant has অ (a) sound combined with it.

(ii) When (a) অ sound is taken away from a consonant, it is left with its pure consonant sound. It is expressed as ক (k), খ (kh)...

The consonants outside the five vargas are:

য র ল ব শ ষ স হ  
ya ra la va sha sa ha

The combined consonants represent the combined sounds of two consonants:

$$\begin{array}{lll}
 \text{ক্ষ} = (\text{ক} + \text{শ}) & \text{ত্র} = (\text{ত} + \text{র}) & \text{ঞ} = (\text{জ} + \text{ন}) \\
 \text{ksha} = k + sha & \text{tra} = t + ra & \text{jna} = j + na
 \end{array}$$
